Note: Enrollment shown reflects following changes: In Fall 1994, Mass Communication moved from College of Arts and Sciences to Manship School of Mass Communication. In Fall 1999, Theatre was moved from College of Arts and Sciences to College of Music & Dramatic Arts.

In Fall 2000, Junior Division was renamed University College (U.C.) Center for Freshman Year. Prior Junior Division Enrollment is shown in the new College.

Also, General College was renamed University College (U.C.) Center for Advising & Counseling. Prior General College enrollment is shown in the new College.

In Fall 2004 University College Evening School was renamed Evening School. In Fall 2008 School of Coast and Environment began enrolling undergraduates in Coastal Environmental Science.

New freshmen were admitted directly to the following senior colleges: Agriculture (1995), Music & Dramatic Arts (2005), & Business Administration (2006).

\*In the Fall 2005 semester, LSU enrolled 2,700 visting students whose college or university was impacted by Hurricane Katrina.

These students are not included in this report.
